### **ORDER TERMINATING GUARDIANSHIP**

The Court being duly advised now finds that:

 $\Box$  The minor has attained eighteen (18) years of age.

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- $\Box$  The minor has
  - $\Box$  died
  - $\Box$  married
  - $\Box$  been adopted

 $\Box$  The protected person is no longer an incapacitated person.

- $\Box$  The protected person has died.
- □ The guardianship property does not exceed the value of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3, 500.00) or said property has been reduced to three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00).
- □ The domicile or physical presence of the protected person has been changed to another state and a guardian has been appointed for the protected person and the protected persons property in that state.
- $\Box$  The guardianship is no longer necessary for any other reason as set forth in the Petition for Termination.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

- $\Box$  The Guardianship herein is terminated.
- □ The final account submitted by the Guardian is approved.

□ The Guardian shall turn over the remaining property of the Guardianship to:

- $\Box$  the minor who has attained eighteen (18) years of age.
- $\Box$  the protected person who is no longer an incapacitated person.
- $\Box$  a person having care and custody of the minor with whom the minor resides.
- □ \_\_\_\_\_, who is responsible for the minor.
- $\Box$  the protected person's personal representative.
- $\Box$  a person who presents the Guardian with an affidavit under IC 29-1-8-1 or IC 29-2-1-2.

- □ The Guardian is hereby released from the duties of their office and discharges from their trust, and all liability of the Guardian and any sureties on their bond are terminated.
- $\Box$  It is further Ordered that the Guardian may pay directly the following:
  - $\Box$  reasonable funeral and burial expenses of the protected person.
  - $\Box$  reasonable expenses of the protected person's last illness.
  - $\Box$  the protected person's federal and state taxes.
  - □ any statutory allowances payable to the protected person's surviving spouse or surviving children.
  - $\Box$  any other obligations of the protected person.
