MINUTES

ELKHART COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

April 20, 2020

President Mike Yoder called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in room 104 in the County Administration Building, 117 North Second Street, Goshen, Indiana. The other Board members, Frank Lucchese and Suzie Weirick, were present. Others present were Patricia Pickens, County Auditor; Craig Buche, County Attorney; Jeff Taylor, County Administrator and Anita Mock Executive Assistant.

On a motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Frank Lucchese and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Minutes of the April 6th & April 13th, 2020 meetings and placed them on file.

On a motion made by Frank Lucchese, seconded by Suzie Weirick and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Allowance of Claims as presented by the County Auditor's office.

County Administrator, Jeff Taylor, received Bids for the 2020 Wedging Program. The bids received are as follows:

Matthews Living Trust represented by Progressive Engineering, Inc. for the vacation of a portion of a north/south county right-of-way known as NURSERY DRIVE north/south portion of Nursery Drive, 390 feet north of County Road 16, 360 feet west of County Road 13, in Concord Township. An In Corp (Seller) represented by Jones Petrie Rafinski for a zone map change from GPUD E-3 to DPUD E-3 and for Primary approval of a 1-lot minor subdivision to be known as TIARA RV DPUD northwest corner of County Road 17 and County Road 104, in Osolo Township. Jones Petrie Rafinski Representative, Matt Schuster, was present to answer any questions in reference to this request. Mike Yoder opened a public hearing.
