**Court's Findings and Order for Rescission of
Lifetime License Suspension**

The Court, having considered the Petitioner's Verified Petition for Rescission of Lifetime License Suspension pursuant to Indiana Code 9-30-10-14.1, having held a hearing, being duly advised in the premises, now finds as follows:

1. Petitioner was present at the hearing.

6. Petitioner's driving privileges were suspended for life on: _____.
7. That over ten (10) years has elapsed since the date on which BMV suspension was issued for the lifetime suspension and Petitioner has not be convicted of a violation described in I.C. 9-30-10-4(a).

8. That the Petitioner has made significant changes in their lifestyle.
9. That the Petitioner no longer poses a threat to the safety of others if driving privileges are reinstated, the continued suspension of driving privileges is unreasonable, and the suspension creates an hardship on Petitioner.
10. It is in society's best interest to permit the Petitioner to regain driving privileges.
11. The Petitioner meets the eligibility requirements of Indiana Code section 9-30-10-14-1.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Petitioner's Lifetime Suspension is Rescinded, and the Petitioner is granted the right to obtain a driver's license pursuant to Indiana Code Section 9-30-10-14.1. The Petitioner shall apply to the BMV for a driver's license and the BMV shall issue a driver's license to the Petitioner if the Petitioner otherwise qualifies for an Indiana driver's license.
