

2025 Coroner's Year End Report

The Coroner's Office saw a 54% increase in total calls for service in 2025 as compared to 2024. Most notably, there was a significant increase in suicides (86%), the majority coming from middle-aged males, while homicides decreased by 10%. No other major changes were noted.

There were 83 autopsies ordered in 2025 compared to 91 autopsies ordered in 2024. To get results from autopsies takes approximately 6-8 weeks depending on the manner of death. Toxicology results take approximately 3 weeks for results to come back.

There are five manners of death that each death is placed in. They are Natural, Accident, Suicide, Homicide, and Undetermined. Listed below are the breakdown for 2025 per manner.

- Natural 195
- Accident 113
- Suicide 27
- Homicide 10
- Undetermined 5

In addition, there are calls for service that the Coroner's Office receives and gathers information on. If it is determined that the death was natural causes, the decedent's primary doctor can and will sign the death certificate. The office refers these types of calls as a "No Response". The total No Response calls for 2025 were 138.
