

SPECIALIZED DRIVING PRIVILEGES

You are INELIGIBLE if:

- You have never been an Indiana resident. *I.C. 9-30-16-1(a)(1)*
- You are suspended because you refused to submit to a chemical test. *I.C. 9-30-16-1(a)(2)*

Determining how to file your case:

*You will need to access your Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) account at **mybmv.com** for your driving record. Sign into your account, click on your driving record, and print the report. If you are unable to do this, visit your local BMV to obtain a copy of your record. This document is MANDATORY for the filing of your case.

- If you have a pending (*not guilty plea has been entered*) operating while intoxicated (*OWI*) case, and the Court has suspended your license or said it will suspend your license while the case is pending, file your petition in that case (*existing case, e.g. 20D04-2508-CM-000978*).
- If you are suspended because of a criminal case(s) and you have already been sentenced, file your petition in EACH case where the court has imposed a license suspension. *I.C. 9-30-16-3*
 - EXCEPTION: If the only court suspension(s) are lifetime (*indefinite*) operating as a habitual traffic violator (*HTV*) criminal case(s), file your petition as a new case in the county you currently live in. This is a civil proceeding and you will be required to pay a filing fee.
- If all of your suspensions are issued from the BMV (*no criminal cases caused them*), file your petition as a new case in the county you currently live in. This is a civil proceeding and you will be required to pay a filing fee. *I.C. 9-30-16-4(d)(1)*
- If you have suspensions issued from the BMV (*no criminal cases caused them*) AND suspensions issued in court case(s) (*criminal case or infraction/ticket case*), file your petition in EACH case where the court has imposed a license suspension. You will not be required to pay a filing fee. *I.C. 9-30-16-4(d)(2)*
