DISASTER EMERGENCY RENEWAL — ELKHART COUNTY, INDIANA

Whereas Elkhart County, Indiana ("Elkhart County"), including municipalities therein, have been threatened by the natural disaster of a tornado and heavy storms;

Whereas Bradley D. Rogers signed a Disaster Emergency Declaration for Elkhart County, Indiana, entered and effective on June 12, 2026;

Whereas a tornado and heavy storms caused significant damage within Elkhart County and public safety responders have been overtaxed;


Whereas Elkhart County Emergency Management along with other local and interjurisdictional agencies has continued responding and providing recovery aspects in alignment with disaster emergency plans during the week of June 15, 2026; and

Whereas an emergency declaration is an appropriate public safety response to the damage caused by the tornado and heavy storms, and further aid and assistance under emergency plans should be furnished;


Now, therefore, under Indiana Code § 10-14-3-29, the local disaster emergency declared by Elkhart County on June 12, 2026, is hereby renewed and will continue in effect through and including June 19, 2026, and an additional 7-day period beyond June 19, 2026. Those parts of the Indiana Code applicable to the conditions which caused issuance of the declaration remain invoked and in effect for exercising all necessary emergency authority for protection of lives and property.

This Renewal was approved and executed this 18th day of June 2026.
