

Elkhart County Emergency Rental Assistance Program

This project is funded through an award made to Elkhart County by the U.S. Department of Treasury through Section 501 of Division N of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021. Elkhart County has entered into a service agreement with Baker Tilly US to administer the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP).

Program Overview

Elkhart County ERAP makes funding available to eligible households to apply to past due and future payments for rent, utilities (water, sewer, stormwater, gas, trash and electricity) and internet. When possible, payments will be made on behalf of tenants directly to landlords and utility companies. The goal of this program is to increase housing stability in Elkhart County.

Funding is available for past due rent and utilities from April 1, 2020 to present, as well as up to 3 months future rent and utilities from the date of application. Past due rent and utilities must be documented through statements and/or invoices from your landlord and utility service provider(s). Eligible applicants will be awarded a maximum of \$1,500 per month for up to six months of past due rent and utility payments. Dependent on fund availability, the County may pay up to 100% of future rent and utility payments up to a maximum of \$1,500 per month.

For future rent and utility assistance beyond three months, the applicant will be required to submit a recertification of income.

Applicant Eligibility

If you meet the following criteria, you may be eligible for this program:

- 1. I reside in a rental unit; I do not own my home;
- 2. I am a resident of Elkhart County;
- 3. I, or a member of my household, qualify for unemployment or have experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced a financial hardship due, directly or indirectly, to COVID-19;
- 4. I can demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability (e.g. past due rent or utility bills);
- 5. My household income is at or below 80 percent of the area median (see table below for area median income information based on household size)

Applicants who meet either of the following criteria will have their applications prioritized for review:

- 1. Households which include an individual that has been unemployed for the 90 days prior to application for assistance; OR
- 2. Households with income at or below 50 percent of the area median (see table below for 50% area median income eligibility information based on household size)

Ineligible applicants

The following applicants are ineligible for this program:

- 1. Homeowners. Applicants are required to be occupying a rental unit or had occupied a rental unit when past due rent or utility costs were incurred;
- 2. Applicants who do not otherwise meet the eligibility criteria outlined in the section above;
- 3. Households that receive a monthly federal subsidy (e.g. a Housing Choice Voucher, Public Housing, or Project-Based Rental Assistance) and/or rental assistance from any other federal, state or local program are only eligible to apply for the portion of rent and utilities which they are responsible for.

Attachment A – Acceptable Documentation Matrix

Note that proof of income must be provided for every adult household member earning income. Applicants must have one piece of documentation from each column; although one document may fulfill multiple columns. For example, a recent unemployment compensation statement can provide proof of financial hardship and be used in determining income eligibility.
