

MINUTES

ELKHART COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

July 26, 2021

President Suzie Weirick called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in room 104 in the County Administration Building, 117 North Second Street, Goshen, Indiana. The other Board members, Frank Lucchese and Brad Rogers were also present. One Bid was received from The Airmarking Company, Inc. in the amount of \$416,957. County Highway Manager of Transportation, Charlie McKenzie, requested approval of Traffic Sign Ordinance recommending a STOP SIGN for the following locations:

- Sunfish Drive for County Road 37
