On a motion made by Bob Barnes, seconded by Suzie Weirick and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Allowance of Claims as presented by the County Auditor's office.

On a motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Bob Barnes and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Minutes of the April 10, 2023 meeting and placed them on file.

Jeff Taylor, County Administrator, Requested approval of Tax Sale addendum between Elkhart County and SRI. On motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Bob Barnes, and unanimously carried, the Board approved this request.

Jennifer Tobey, Emergency Management, requested Grant Application Review form For IDHS 2023 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) in the amount of \$9500.00 for Livescan Software for information sharing. Jennifer Tobey, Emergency Management requested Grant Application Review form For IDHS 2023 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) in the amount of \$81,908.50 for IT Department for Cybersecurity. On motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Bob Barnes, and unanimously carried, the Board approved this request. (Page 220)

Jeff Taylor, County Administrator, requested a 10×20 small storage building to be used To store recycle bins and barrels that are used at the Elkhart County 4-H Fairgrounds for the Green Earth Day and the Green committee, which this is the 14^{th} year for the recycle program. This has kept more than 22 tons of plastic items out of the landfill. The estimate on the building Is \$6800.00 and would be funded by the Solid waste funds, which encourages the promotion of Recycling. This building would be used for storage in the winter, and could possibly be used by The Parks Department for their displays in the summer during the fair. On motion made by Suzie Weirick, seconded by Bob Barnes, and unanimously carried, the Board approved this request.
