Guardianship vs Petition for Custody for a Child

Now that you have completed this form, review these notes to help determine if a Petition for Custody should be filed rather than a Guardianship for a child:

- If the child has no property and no money is due or coming to the child, then a custody petition under IC 31-17-2-3(2) is more appropriate because it does not require the many technical and ongoing yearly requirements of guardianships. It is less expensive for the custodians and equally serves the needs of the child.
- If there is an existing Juvenile Paternity or Dissolution of Marriage case, then a petition or motion in that case per IC 31-17-2-3 (2) is appropriate. If there are no such cases, then a Petition for Custody may be filed as a new Miscellaneous Civil (MI) case.
