ELKHART COUNTY COUNCIL
Public Hearing/Budget Hearing
August 28th, 2018

The meeting of the Elkhart County Council was called to order by President John Letherman at 8:30 a.m., in Room 104 of the County Administrative Building, Goshen, Indiana. Public Hearing/Budget Hearing:

Open Public Hearing: On motion made by Riegsecker and seconded by Stump, the council unanimously carried and opened the Public Meeting.

President John Letherman asked for questions on the 2019 Budget. Letherman discussed the schedule for holding the Budget Hearings next week. There was some discussion among the Council pertaining to Court Services, Public Defender's Office and the Prosecutor's Office. There were no further questions from Council or Audience.
